



ROSE QUARTER UNDERGROUND:

Looking at conditions from the bottom up

Upcoming field work in the area

As soon as October 20, and throughout the month of November, crews will continue soil and hazardous material sampling throughout the Rose Quarter area. Work will occur Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. Sampling will occur at:

- the parking lot adjacent to the Crowne Plaza Hotel just south of NE Weidler St and east of the I-5 North 302A Exit off-ramp to NE Broadway/NE Weidler St and the Moda Center
- the parking lot south of the Sherwin Williams paint store between NE Weidler St and NE Broadway and between N Williams Ave and NE Victoria Ave
- the parking lot behind the Leftbank Annex between N Weidler St and N Broadway and between N Vancouver Ave and N Williams Ave
- the parking lot adjacent to the Shell station between NE Broadway and NE Hancock St and between N Williams Ave and NE Victoria Ave

Work is expected to take up to three days at each location; Specific dates will be coordinated with the property owners. People traveling in the area will see drilling equipment and can expect typical construction impacts such as a slight increase in noise, vibration and dust. There are no anticipated lane closures or detours for people travelling through the area. Parking at some businesses may be temporarily restricted when work is occurring at a specific location.

What is soil and hazardous material sampling?

The work will ensure that designs are appropriate for local soil conditions and that construction activities are done safely. To sample materials, crews will use a truck-mounted drill rig to dig holes and collect soil and material for analysis. Holes will be filled once a sample has been collected.

What is the project?

Interstate 5 between I-84 and I-405 is the top traffic bottleneck in Oregon and the 28th worst bottleneck in the nation. It also has:

- some of the highest traffic volumes in the State of Oregon with 12 hours of traffic congestion each day
- a crash rate 3.5 times higher than the statewide average
- a lack of full shoulders in key areas for crashes to clear and emergency vehicles to access
- nearby local streets lacking neighborhood connections and with undersized or incomplete pedestrian and bicycle facilities

The I-5 Rose Quarter Improvement Project will add auxiliary lanes and shoulders that smooth traffic flow and improve operations to make local and regional travel more predictable and safer for people driving and transporting goods. It includes street improvements to enhance safety and access for people walking, rolling, riding transit and driving on local streets. The project will support the regional economy, future economic development and a more connected and equitable Albina community.
